## **THREE OF A THEME PROJECTED DIGITAL IMAGE COMPETITION**

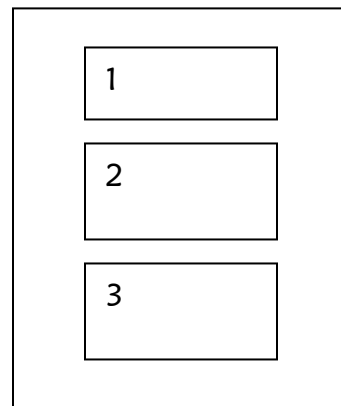
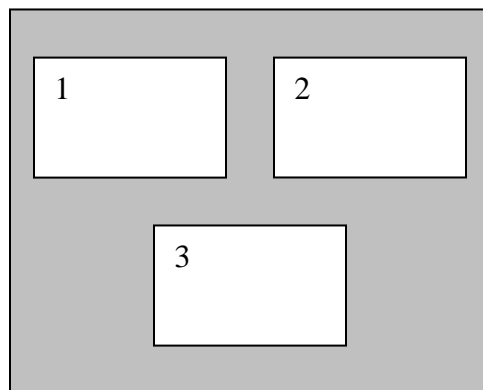
There are different ways to prepare the one 'canvas' with different software. The following are guidelines for Photoshop/Elements but you should be able to achieve this with other software.

- <File – New> – select A4 size and rotate if landscape format desired.
- Ensure RGB colour is selected via <Image – Mode>
- Select colour on Canvas – probably black/grey or white - Save Canvas with Title
- Open 3 images for –Three of a Theme
- Using Move tool (top of toolbox) drag each image onto blank canvas (each image will be on its own layer). Original images can then be closed
- Using each individual layer, position images on blank canvas
- Flatten Image when satisfied
- Crop Canvas to give satisfactory border
- <Image – Resize> to either 1400 x 1050 maximum for landscape / 1050 high for portrait
- Save As JPEG with Title
- Submit with form above – giving just name and title

You may like to define your 3 images with a border, bearing in mind you'll probably be using a black background. Before dragging images into the new canvas - <Select all> - <Edit> <Stroke> - select your colour and line width <OK> <Select – deselect>

You might like to experiment with different shapes within the image, but if you're not sure the guidelines above are satisfactory. If you have difficulty, please save your 3 images onto disk, complete the form below and let Gill know that you require assistance – we'll be happy to help.
