How to resize and export an image in Lightroom Mobile

- 1. **Open your image** in the editing view of the Lightroom Mobile app.
- 2. Tap the **Share icon** (a square with an arrow pointing up) at the top of the screen.
- 3. In the pop-up menu, select **Export as...** to open the export settings dialog.
- 4. In the Export dialog, tap on **Dimensions**.
- 5. Choose **Custom** from the list of options.
- 6. Enter your desired pixel size for the **long edge** of the photo (1600 if a landscape image, or 1200 if a portrait image). The other edge will be scaled proportionally.
- 7. Adjust the **Image Quality** slider (from 10% to 100%) to control the final file size.
- 8. Tap **More Options** for additional settings, like file type (JPG is the most common), output sharpening for screen or print, and colour space.
- 9. Tap the checkmark or **Done** to begin the export process.
- 10. The exported file will be saved to your device with the new, custom dimensions.
