

Resize an Image and Add a Stroke Border in Photoshop

Resize Image (Change Dimensions)

- 1. Open your image in Photoshop.
- 2. Go to the top menu \rightarrow Image \rightarrow Image Size...
- 3. In the pop-up window:
 - o Make sure "Constrain Proportions" (the chain link icon) is enabled so the image doesn't stretch.
 - o Enter your desired Width (1600) and Height (1200) (in pixels)
- 4. Click OK.

Stroke Layer Style (flexible & editable)

- 1. Double-click your image layer (unlock it if needed).
- 2. At the bottom of the Layers Panel, click the fx icon \rightarrow Stroke.
- 3. In the options:
 - o **Size**: Controls border thickness.
 - o **Position**: Choose **Inside** (sharp corners).
 - o Color: Pick your border color.
- 4. Click $OK \rightarrow$ now the border is editable anytime.
- 5. File/Export/Export As...Format: jpg, Export, pick location.

Your images will now be exported as JPEG files with a maximum width of 1600 pixels and a maximum height of 1200 pixels.
