



## Resize an Image and Add a Stroke Border in Photoshop

### Resize Image (Change Dimensions)

1. **Open your image** in Photoshop.
2. Go to the **top menu** → **Image** → **Image Size...**
3. In the pop-up window:
  - Make sure “**Constrain Proportions**” (the chain link icon) is enabled so the image doesn’t stretch.
  - Enter your desired **Width (1600)** and **Height (1200)** (in pixels)
4. Click **OK**.

### Stroke Layer Style (flexible & editable)

1. Double-click your image layer (unlock it if needed).
2. At the bottom of the **Layers Panel**, click the **fx** icon → **Stroke**.
3. In the options:
  - **Size**: Controls border thickness.
  - **Position**: Choose **Inside** (sharp corners).
  - **Color**: Pick your border color.
4. Click **OK** → now the border is editable anytime.
5. **File/Export/Export As...Format: jpg, Export, pick location.**

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Your images will now be exported as JPEG files with a maximum width of 1600 pixels and a maximum height of 1200 pixels.
