



Resize an Image with Specific Dimensions in Preview for macOS and Export for PDI Competition

1. **Open the image in Preview**
 - Double-click the image file. By default, it should open in Preview.
 - If it opens in another app, right-click the file → **Open With** → **Preview**.
2. **Open the Resize Tool**
 - In the top menu bar, go to **Tools** → **Adjust Size....**
3. **Set new dimensions**
 - A dialog box will appear with options for **width, height, and resolution**.
 - Make sure “**Scale proportionally**” (or “**Lock aspect ratio**”) is checked.
 - Enter the new dimensions (**1600 x 1200 in pixels**).
4. **Change resolution if needed**
 - Adjust the **Resolution (pixels per inch)** if you want to reduce or increase image quality/print size.
5. **Apply changes**
 - Click **OK**. The image will resize.
6. **Save the resized image**
 - To overwrite the original, go to **File** → **Save**.
 - To keep both versions, use **File** → **Export...** and save under a new name.

Your images will now be exported as JPEG files with a maximum width of 1600 pixels and a maximum height of 1200 pixels.
