

## Resize an Image with Specific Dimensions in Windows Photos for PDI Competition

## 1. Open the photo

o Right-click your image file  $\rightarrow$  select **Open with**  $\rightarrow$  choose **Photos**.

## 2. Open the Resize menu

- o In the top toolbar, click the **three dots** (...) (More options).
- Select Resize.
- 3. Choose a size option
  - **Custom dimensions** set your own width and height.
- 4. Adjust custom size
  - o Check that **Maintain aspect ratio** is locked.
  - o Enter the width (1600) and height (1200) in pixels. If your image is a non-standard size, ensure that neither dimension is over the relevant limit.

## 5. Save the resized image

- o After choosing, click Save resized copy.
- Pick a folder and file name (it won't overwrite the original unless you choose the same name/location).

Your images will now be exported as JPEG files with a maximum width of 1600 pixels and a maximum height of 1200 pixels.
